year. Mindful of traditions related to the

celebration of the Feast of St. Patrick, Bishop

McGovern has granted Catholics in the Diocese of

Belleville a dispensation (an exemption) from the

obligation to abstain from eating meat on Saint

Patrick's Day on Friday, March 17, 2023.

dispensation are encouraged to abstain from meat

on some other day as part of their penitential

practices during Lent.
